STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT
ADOPTION STATEMENT

Notice is hereby given that North Lincolnshire Council has formally adopted the Statement of Community Involvement on 20th August 2018, in accordance with the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012.

The Statement of Community Involvement sets out how the Council will work with the community as well as partners and stakeholders in the production of Local Plans, Neighbourhood Plans, Supplementary Planning Documents, and the determination of Planning Applications; it outlines the consultation and involvement processes and monitoring arrangements. It also sets out how the Council will provide support for neighbourhood planning.

This document replaces the previous Statement of Community Involvement, adopted in July 2010. It can also be viewed via the link on the council's public access computer network, at Local Links and Libraries in North Lincolnshire.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Statement of Community Involvement may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of the decision to adopt the document. Any challenge must be made on the grounds that either the document has not been prepared within the powers conferred by the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, or alternatively that a requirement of the Act or associated regulations has not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than Wednesday 26th September 2018.
